  - \$285,082.82 as of Today (\$60,000 for reverse renewal fund 2023)
  - \$74,439.48 in Fire truck account as of today
  - \$200,000 1-year non-redeemable Term Deposit June 16, 2023
  - \$36,314.24 in BRVFD account as of today
- 5. UNFINISHED BUSINESS
  - Street lighting
    - No lights are out
  - Volunteer Fire Department
    - Update from the fire chief
      - Working on training up Erik, our newest member.
      - We closed our CEPF grant from last year. We will do some focused training with instructors in the spring as the final bit of the training.
      - I was successful in another grant from CEPF for a little under 30k. This grant has no training involved.
         It is all equipment and I will work to get it set in January/February.
      - That puts us up well over 100k in grants over the past couple years! Awesome!
      - o We had a couple call outs over the past quarter. Simple calls but we were effective in our response.
      - During our last course the instructor took a few of our older helmets as donation for Departments in other countries. After we purchase our new gear we will have a review of what we have and see if there are more things we can have delivered to Kamloops for donation. No point in hanging on to stuff we can't use!
      - o There was a call out to a chimney fire at Caroline's.
    - The search is on for a crew/supply pick-up truck. Still on the hunt Budget set to no more than \$60,000.00.
    - Andy is applying for another Community Emergency Preparedness Fund grant for more gear. Half is paid up
      front and half when the purchases are complete.
      - New suits and air tanks will be purchased with the grant if we get it.
        - Andy was successful in getting the grant
    - Compressor
      - Need a new compressor. Rui made a motion to purchase a new or refurbished compressor for up to \$6500.00. Bruce seconded. AIF
      - o needs to be pumped from the outside.- Fixed now being pumped from outside
    - More detail in the accounting to track grants. Adding GI accounts but also working on a running total spreadsheet for easy viewing and running totals from year to year. In progress
