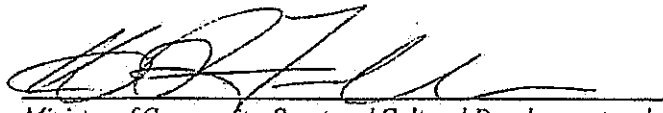
I, Peter Fassbender, Minister of Community, Sport and Cultural Development and Minister Responsible for TransLink, order that the letters patent issued on May 23, 1956 (the "Letters Patent") for Blue River Improvement District be amended as follows:

1. The area of Blue River Improvement District is altered to include the land shaded and described as the extension area in the attached map titled "Schedule 1 to the Letters Patent of Blue River Improvement District."
2. All boundaries of Blue River Improvement District set out in letters patent are repealed.
3. Section 1 of the Letters Patent is amended by striking out everything before "and the owners of land therein" and replacing it with the following:

The tract of land including all foreshore and land covered by water consisting of a total land area of 535.32 hectares within the boundary of the improvement district as shown outlined on the map, being Map Reference Number 026.1, dated January 15, 2016, attached as Schedule 1 to these Letters Patent,

4. By repealing the current Schedule 1 to the Letters Patent and replacing it with the attached map titled "Schedule 1 to the Letters Patent of Blue River Improvement District" cited as Map Reference Number 026.1 dated January 15, 2016.

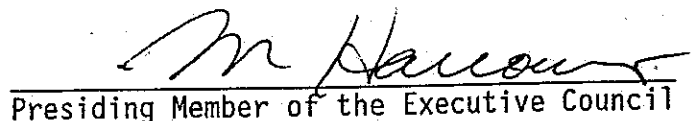

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

1. The Letters Patent for the Blue River Improvement District dated May 23, 1956, be amended by striking out section 3 in its entirety and substituting the following therefore:
 - "3. The objects of the improvement district shall be the acquisition, maintenance and operation of works for garbage collection, street lighting, fire protection and community hall purposes and all matters incidental thereto."
2. All assets and liabilities of the Blue River Improvement District relating to the operation and maintenance of a community water system, whether real or contingent, be transferred to the Thompson-Nicola Regional District.
3. All bylaws of the Blue River Improvement District regulating a water system or charging for costs related to a water system which are in force and effect as of March 31, 1995, are declared to be bylaws of the Thompson-Nicola Regional District and continue in force and effect until amended or repealed by the Regional Board.
4. This Order is effective as and from midnight, March 31, 1995.

AND WHEREAS it is provided in section 825 of the Municipal Act that the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may at any time amend the Letters Patent of any improvement district in any respect:

AND WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Blue River Improvement District have requested that the boundaries of the district be extended:

AND WHEREAS prior to the issuance of these Supplementary Letters Patent no metes and bounds description of the Improvement District had been prepared:

NOW KNOW YE THAT by these presents We do order and proclaim that the boundaries of Blue River Improvement District be amended and that on, from and after the date of these Supplementary Letters Patent the boundaries of the Blue River Improvement District be defined as follows:

Firstly: Commencing at the most northerly corner of Block B of Lot 3285, Kamloops Division of Yale District, being a point on the natural highwater mark of Blue River, on the right bank thereof; thence in a general southeasterly direction along said highwater mark to the point of intersection with the northwesterly limit of Highway Number 5, Yellowhead South, as shown on Registered Plan H8885, on file in the Land Title Office, Kamloops; thence northeasterly along the northwesterly limit of

3278; thence easterly and southerly along the northerly and easterly boundaries of the Northwest Quarter of Lot 3278 to the point of intersection with the natural highwater mark of Eleanor Lake, on the northerly shore thereof; thence in a general easterly and southerly direction along the said northerly and easterly shores of Eleanor Lake to the point of intersection with the northerly boundary of the Southeast Quarter of Lot 3278; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of said Southeast Quarter of Lot 3278 to the point of intersection with the southeasterly limit of Canadian National Railway Company's right-of-way as shown on Registered Plan R227; thence northeasterly along the southeasterly limit of said Canadian National Railway right-of-way to the southwest corner of Lot 1 of Lot 3278, Registered Plan 2165; thence easterly along the southerly boundaries of said Lot 1, Plan 2165 and Block B of Lot 3279 to the southeast corner of said Block B of Lot 3279; thence southerly along the southerly prolongation of the easterly boundary of Block B of Lot 3279 to the point of intersection with the northerly boundary of Block A of Lot 3279; thence easterly, southerly and westerly along the northerly, easterly and southerly boundaries of said Block A of Lot 3279 and continuing westerly along the westerly prolongation of the southerly boundary of Block A of Lot 3279 to the point of intersection with the westerly boundary of Lot 3279; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of Lot 3279 to the southwest corner thereof; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of Lot 3274 to the point of intersection with the natural highwater mark of Blue River on the right bank thereof; thence in a general southerly direction along said right bank of Blue River and continuing southerly along the natural highwater mark of North

and except therefrom Lot 14 of Lot 3272, Registered Plan 2088 and that part of Lot 3275 lying to the east of the Canadian National Railway Company's right-of-way.

Secondly: The Northwest Quarter of Lot 3277, Kamloops Division of Yale District.

Thirdly: Blocks D and G of Lot 3283, Kamloops Division of Yale District.

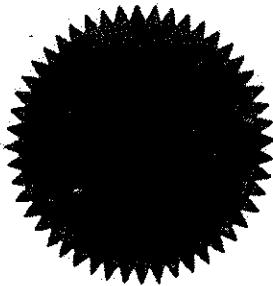
